Use this checklist to assess the homes of you and/or your loved ones for safety. **Remember to periodically re-check the home.**

All Areas of The Home

Cords: YES ____ NO ____ Are lamp, extension, and telephone cords placed out of the flow of traffic? YES ____ NO ____ Are cords out from beneath furniture and rugs or carpeting? (For safety, correct answer is no.) YES ____ NO ____ Are electrical cords in good condition, not frayed or cracked? YES ____ NO ____ Do extension cords carry no more than their proper load, as indicated by the ratings labeled on the cord and the appliance? **Rugs, runners, and mats:** YES ____ NO____ Are all small rugs and runners slip-resistant? **Telephones:** YES ____ NO ____ Are emergency numbers posted on or near the telephones? YES NO Is there easy access to a telephone in case of a fall (or some other emergency which prevents from standing and reaching a wall phone)? **Smoke detectors:** YES ____ NO ____ Are smoke detectors properly located? YES ____ NO ____ Are the smoke detectors working properly? Are batteries changed regularly? **Electrical outlets and switches:** YES ____ NO ____ Are any outlets and switches unusually warm or hot to the touch? (For safety, correct answer is no.) YES ____ NO ____ Do all outlets and switches have cover plates, so that no wiring is exposed?

YES _____ NO ____ Are light bulbs the appropriate size and type for the lamp or fixture?

Space heaters:

- YES ____ NO ____ Are heaters which come with a 3-prong plug being used in a 3-hole outlet or with a properly attached adapter?
- YES ____ NO ____ Are small stoves and heaters placed where they cannot be knocked over, and away from furnishings and flammable materials, such as curtains or rugs?
- YES ____ NO ____ If there is space heating equipment, such as a kerosene heater, gas heater or LP gas heater, does she/he understand the installation and operating instructions thoroughly?

YES NO	_ Are hallways, passageways between rooms, and other heavy traffic areas
	well lit?

	Are steps even and of the same size and height?
	_ Are any rugs or other coverings on the steps in good condition?
	_ Can she/he clearly see the edges of the steps?
	(If not, consider marking with tape or paint.)

	_ Are bathtubs and showers equipped with non-skid mats, abrasive strips, or

YES ____ NO ____ Do bathtubs and showers have at least one (preferably two) grab bars?

- YES ____ NO ____ Is the water temperature 120 degrees or lower?
- YES ____ NO ____ Is a light switch located near the entrance to the bathroom?
- YES ____ NO ____ Are small electrical appliances such as hair dryers, shavers, curling irons, etc., unplugged when not in use?
- YES ____ NO ____ Are all medicines stored in the containers that they came in, and are they clearly marked?

		the grounding pin or by improperly using an adapter?

		fumes stored away from ignition sources?
